

## **Kangaroo Kids Fund Distribution Guidelines**

Kangaroo Kids is currently tracking two separate funds that do not currently have guidelines established for qualifying distributions from them. The purpose of this document is to establish these guidelines to be used by the Kangaroo Kids Executive Board of Directors to qualify distributions from these funds.

### **Ebi Short Memorial Fund**

This Memorial Fund was established in honor and memory of a lifetime member, Ebi Short, who passed away in 2016. She was an energetic jumper, coach, and friend on the Kangaroo Kids whose passion bubbled over and influenced all around her. In fact one of her favorite sayings was "Capture Life". This fund's intent was to be used for donations to community organizations that reflect Ebi's joy for life, photography, jump rope, etc.

Guidelines for distribution of this fund are:

1. Requests for distributions of the Ebi Short Memorial fund will be provided to the executive board of directors in writing.
2. Approval of distribution of the funds requires the answer to all of the questions below to be affirmative:
  - a. Does the request benefit a person, group, or organization that reflects Jump Rope or Photography?
  - b. Will the recipient be afforded an opportunity which they would not be able to do if the funding did not come from this fund?
  - c. Is the amount of the request within the current amount of money in the fund.

The Kangaroo Kids Executive Board of directors will evaluate requests which meet the guidelines and provide distributions at their discretion.

### **Kangaroo Kids Scholarship Fund**

The Kangaroo Kids Scholarship Fund was established with the intent to open Jump Rope opportunities to those that could not afford it. These funds are intended to be need based and will be distributed at the discretion of the Executive Board of Directors for any of the following uses:

1. Providing funds for the purchase of Jump Ropes to be given to people, groups, or organizations that could benefit from them.
2. Providing funds to offset costs associated with registration, tuition, membership, uniforms, or other costs to Jump Rope classes, teams, workshops, festivals, or other jump rope education.
3. Providing funds to offset costs with providing a Jump Rope performance (e.g. travel, coaching costs, etc.) to a group or organization that would not otherwise be able to have a performance.
